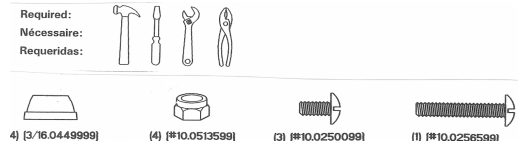
MAINTENANCE ASSEMBLY & RELAY
